The Emerald Ash Borer is Coming

The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) is coming to Central Iowa and has been spotted as close as the Newton area. EAB kills all Ash trees and is considered the most destructive tree pest ever seen in North America. There are quite a few Ash trees in the Douglas Acres neighborhood, both on City property and in private yards. The City has begun the process of identifying which trees need to be removed from City property and have actually removed some of them this Spring. The City intends to notify the homeowner at least 3 days before removal. Once the tree has been cut down, another contractor will return at a later date and take out the remaining stump.

If you have an Ash tree on the City "parking" in front of your home and it is cut down, you can request that another tree be planted by the City. When you visit that website, you can read the City of Des Moines Emerald Ash Borer Management Plan and find links to a variety of resources regarding this topic.
